- ✘ Applicants may receive more than one award but only up to a total of £250.
- ✘ Applications will be received only on the official application form.
- ✘ Young Lancashire will seek to make the awards on a bi-monthly basis: therefore applicants should have to wait no longer than two months for a decision.
- ✘ Applicants will be required to provide brief details of how they have used their award, and how they have benefited from it.
- ✘ The decision of the panel is final.
